Pastor's Notes



HAPPY FATHER'S DAY

On Sunday, June 21 we observe Father's Day. We extend best wishes to all the fathers in our community. If your dad is living, be sure to talk with him on Sunday. If he lives close by, visit him and spend some time together. If your father is deceased, be sure to pray for him at Mass. May God bless all fathers today.

ARE YOU AN ATTORNEY?

On June 22 the Church celebrates the Feast of St. Thomas More, who is the patron saint of attorneys. Born in London in 1478, More was educated at Oxford and began a legal career that led him to Parliament. More's talents attracted the attention of King Henry VIII, who gave him several government appointments until promoting him to Lord Chancellor in 1529. At the height of his career, More resigned his position in 1532 due to increasing tension concerning King Henry's decision to make himself the head of the Church in England. Unwilling to give up allegiance to the pope as the visible head of the Church on earth, More was imprisoned in the Tower of London and executed on July 6, 1535. St. Thomas More is recognized as a man of great integrity who refused to violate his conscience even under enormous pressure. The Church offers him as a patron saint for attorneys; I also consider him a patron saint for all who work to uphold religious liberty in our nation today. I encourage attorneys to attend Mass on the Feast of St. Thomas More. St. Thomas More, pray for us.

ON A MISSION

This Wednesday, June 24, people from St. Mary's will travel to the town of Jinotepe in Nicaragua. We will spend a week visiting the young people and staff at Nuestros Pequeños Hermanos home. Many St. Mary's parishioners remember the children from NPH who visited our parish in October 2012 and who sang at the weekend liturgies. This mission trip is a terrific opportunity to go and see the young people and the community that is their home. Please keep all who are traveling in your prayers this week.

PETER'S PENCE

Next weekend our second collection is in support of the charitable work of the Holy Father. Pope Francis receives requests for charitable help from around the globe. The "Peter's Pence" collection is our opportunity to help the Holy Father respond to those requests. As a sign of the universal ministry of Pope Francis, we invite you to include foreign currency that you may still have from trips that we can exchange and include in our donation to Peter's Pence.

CAN I GET A WITNESS?

I spent the week of June 8 on retreat with a large number of priests, which included several talks by Peter Cardinal Turkson, President of the Pontifical Council of Justice and Peace. Cardinal Turkson used to teach Sacred Scripture at the seminary in his native Ghana, and his strong academic background was evident in his excellent presentations. He spoke to us on June 11, the Feast of St. Barnabas. Cardinal Turkson pointed out that Barnabas had a strong conviction that personal witness was crucial for the spread of the Christian faith. Hence, Barnabas sent for Paul the Apostle to come to Antioch and share with the people the story of his conversion from being a Pharisee who persecuted Christians to becoming the most ardent proclaimer of the Gospel.

The need for personal witness is true in our time as well. Each one of us has experienced the call of the Lord and a conversion of life toward Jesus Christ. But do we share our story with other people? Do we sometimes miss the opportunity to strengthen the faith of others as well as our own faith by instead keeping mum about the power of Christ at work in the very real circumstances of our lives? So here is an idea: this summer take the time to write down your own story of faith. Then prayerfully consider who you would like to share your story with. It could be a family member, a priest, or your best friend. Taking this opportunity can be strengthening for you, for another person and for the Church. I will share more thoughts from the retreat next week.

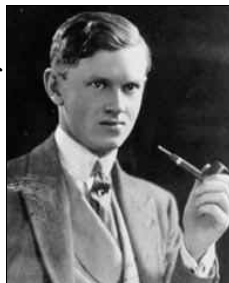

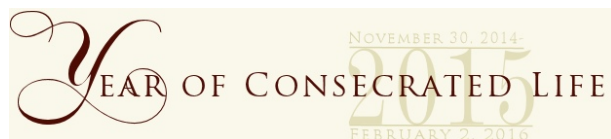


