In order to address these concerns, I've invited Bob Gilligan, the Director of the Illinois Catholic Conference, to speak here at St. Mary on Thursday, July 30 at 7:00pm. Bob works with the Catholic Bishops of Illinois (Chicago, Joliet, Springfield, Belleville, Rockford and Peoria) in representing to elected officials the hopes and concerns of our Catholic dioceses and institutions. The evening promises to be insightful and generate practical ideas for promoting religious liberty. We will meet in the parish center conference room, 201 E. Illinois at 7:00pm.
