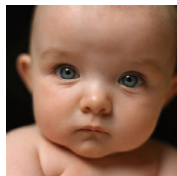

Religious Education Program

For the months of September, October and November, the students are learning about Saint Faustina Kowalska and the virtue of mercy. At a time when some Catholics had an image of God as a strict judge that they might be tempted to despair about the possibility of being forgiven, Jesus chose to emphasize His mercy and forgiveness. Our Lord appeared to St. Faustina and told her "I do not want to punish aching mankind, but I desire to heal it, pressing it to my merciful heart" (Diary 1588). Through the story of St. Faustina, students learned both about the infinite mercy of God and the importance of extending mercy to others.

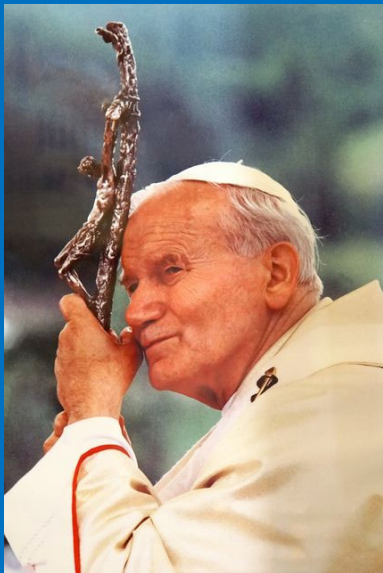




