PRAYING FOR LIFE

Friday, January 22 marks the 43rd anniversary of the Supreme Court decision in Roe vs. Wade which legalized abortion in our country. The legacy of the decision is tragic: the death of more than 55 million children in the womb. I also think of the women and men who participated in an abortion and now deeply regret their actions. Echoing the invitation of Pope Francis, I encourage any person who has procured an abortion to meet the Lord Jesus in the Sacrament of Reconciliation and ask for the Lord's mercy and forgiveness. Priests are available for confession on Saturdays at 8:30am, Wednesdays at 6pm as well as by appointment. There is also Project Rachel, a special ministry for those who were involved in an abortion and now seek forgiveness and healing; you can confidentially contact Project Rachel at 312.337.1962.

Prayer and positive action are needed to foster a culture that respects and cherishes every human being. St. Mary is sponsoring a bus for those who would like to participate in the Rally for Life in downtown Chicago on Sunday, January 17. The bus will depart from St. Mary at 1:00pm. Also, everyone is invited to the Mass for Life on Thursday, January 21 at 7:00pm. I also encourage donations to charities such as Aid for Women and Heather's House in Des Plaines. Life is a gift from God; let's each do our part to cherish that great gift each day.

PARISH TRANSITION

Last week members of our parish staff participated in a retreat day led by Father Ron Lewinski. An important topic for reflection was transition: the upcoming change of pastor and the transition we are experiencing in our parish. It was helpful to reflect on our people, the strengths of our parish and the needs we can identify. It was a good opportunity to think about where we are at today and how the parish can develop in the coming year.

At this point I am organizing a small transition team with representatives from the parish council, finance council, school, religious education program, and staff. The transition team will help prepare a "state of the parish" summary, give some guidance about remaining tasks that need to be done before I conclude my term and then assist the new pastor as he begins on July 1.

There will be some opportunities for me to visit and say "thank you" to parishioners in the spring. Please mark your calendar for Saturday, June 11, 2016. I will offer the 5:00pm Mass and there will be a reception afterward in the Upper Grade Center gym. I anticipate being present at St. Mary until June 30.

A reminder that the pastor appointment process still has some weeks to go and it will be probably mid-March before Archbishop Cupich makes his decision. Please keep our parish in your prayers in the coming weeks. Thank you.

PRAYER FOR CHRISTIAN UNITY

At the Last Supper, our Lord Jesus prayed: "Father, may they all be one." The splintering of Christianity over the centuries has weakened our life as united disciples and witnesses of Jesus. Beginning January 18, Christian denominations are encouraged to celebrate a Week of Prayer for Christian Unity. In a particular way this year, I'd like to pray for Christians who are being persecuted because of their faith, that the Holy Spirit help them and strengthen them.






COR Meeting - God's Not Dead!




