

## **South Coast Championships, Eton Dorney – 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2017.**

### **EMERGENCY PLAN**

- In the event of an emergency occurring during the regatta, the emergency / rescue services will be co-ordinated from the regatta control situated on the ground floor of the Dorney Lake Rowing Centre.
- Regatta control will have direct radio communications with the safety boats, the First Aid station, all Regatta officials, and with all club officials, competitors and spectators via the PA system.
- There will be a mobile telephone at Regatta Control, which can be used to call for additional assistance, ambulance or rescue services as required.
- The Regatta Controller will co-ordinate the rescue or in his absence the Safety Advisor will act on his behalf and will take control.
- The decision to suspend the regatta will be made by the South Coast Championship panel nominated on the day following consultation with the Regatta Controller, Emergency Services and Racing Officials.
- If the Emergency takes place on the water, the rescue of those involved will be under the control of the rescue boat who will co-ordinate all the rescue activities afloat including any other rescue craft available.
