BOAT INSPECTION CHECK LIST.

This check list will be used by the Boat inspection team.

All Club boats to be used at the regatta must be inspected before use to ensure that they comply with BR Row Safe guidelines.

This check list should also be used by Clubs to check their boats before they are inspected at the regatta.

1. BUOYANCY TANKS.

Split/Tear/Lifting tape/Damage to Beading or missing Bung/Other

All buoyancy tank hatches and bungs must be in place and watertight, temporary tape repairs will not be sufficient to pass the inspection.

2. STRETCHERS.

Bolts missing/length.

3. HEEL RESTRAINTS.

Concept2 Style foot plates ? Yes/No

Restraints must be separately attached to the boat (not looped to each shoe)

Concept2 style foot plates – heel restraints must have 2 fixing points from the heel to a fixed point(s)

4. RIGGERS .

Bolts to long/sharpedge

5. SHELL.

Condition/Splits/Holes/rough edges/protruding screws

6. STEERING.

Condition/line frayed/line broken/Rudder lines attached in such away that cox cannot get entangled

7. SELF BAILERS.

Condition/leaking/not operating

8. NUMBER BRACKET & NUMBERS.

Condition/not secure/to close to rower/ Numbers should have rounded corners/correct colours

Any boat not having a Boat Inspected label will not be permitted to go afloat.

All boats will be inspected for the Inspection Label by the Beach Marshal before going afloat.
