**2019 ASSESSMENTS** – Mr. Garofalo reminded the Board that second installments payments are due and payable by May 30, 2019.

#### **EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR:**

AUDITOR AND ACTUARY YEAR-END REPORTS - Ms. Lauren Holman was present to review the 2018 year-end audit. Prior to the Auditor beginning her report, Mr. Sacco referred to the Financial Fast Track report as of March 31<sup>st</sup>. He noted that over the past month, eight 2018 claims that had reserve changes that went to the JIF retention of \$300,000. Mr. Sacco further noted that the 2018 fund year has a deficit of 3.3 million and it is mostly caused by Workers' Comp and Property. Mr. Sacco informed the Board that he and the other Fund Professionals have met, and will continue to meet, to discuss the best course of action moving forward. He then asked Ms. Holman to provide her report. Ms. Holman reported that the Independent Audit Report had a clean opinion and that it was unmodified with no exceptions. She further reported that the Review of Internal Controls drew no comments or findings. Ms. Holman asked if there were any questions from the Board on the Auditors' report. Hearing none, Mr. Sacco indicated that a motion was needed to approve the audit, adopt the enclosed Resolution certifying the audit, and execute the Group Affidavit.

He referred to Resolution 15-19, as well as, the Indemnity and Trust Agreement, renewing the Fund's membership in the Municipal Excess Liability Joint Insurance Fund for the period of July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2022. Mr. Sacco asked if there were any questions. Hearing none, he asked for a motion to adopt Resolution 15-19.

#### **SAFETY DIRECTOR:**

Mr. Mirarchi reviewed the April activities and the May agenda. He advised the Committee of upcoming meetings and trainings. He then referred to the Safety Director's bulletins that were recently released enclosed within the agenda booklet.

Lastly, Mr. Mirarchi informed the Board that J.A. Montgomery is strongly encouraging that each member have two representatives attend one of the DER training courses as it is very informative. He noted that it is a six hour course.

#### **UNDERWRITING MANAGER:**

Mr. Cooney reported that cyber security continues to be a popular topic in the news. He informed the Board that he had been contacted by the FBI to assist with the JIF's recent cyber issues. He asked that members continue to participate in the Cyber Risk Management Program and noted that 85 members in the entire MEL system are compliant.

Mr. Cooney also reported that Hurricane season is approaching. He advised that J.A. Montgomery will be releasing a bulletin pertaining to best practices for the season.

#### **RISK MANAGEMENT CONSULTANT:**

Mr. Avalone reported that the 2020 data renewal process has begun. He noted that part of the process this year will include the required statutory bond renewal underwriting process for all members renewing with the Ocean JIF in 2020.

Mr. Avalone advised that the Attorney General announced that a two-day training session on resiliency and coping methods for stress and mental anguish for law enforcement officers is being planned for October in Trenton.

#### **MANAGED CARE:**

Ms. Goldstein began by thanking the Board for reappointment on behalf of Medlogix. She then referred to her report contained in the agenda booklet. She

informed the Board that for the month of March there was a savings of \$520,347.90 or 53.37% on the medical billing for Workers' Compensation claims and for the month of April there was a savings of \$384,088.25. Ms. Goldstein then referred to the quarterly injury report that was distributed prior to the meeting which breaks down the different types of injuries reported during the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter of 2019.

R.S. 52:27BB-52 - "A local officer or member of a local governing body who, after a date fixed for compliance, fails or refuses to obey an order of the director (Director of Local Government Services), under the provisions of this Article, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, may be fined not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) or imprisoned for not more than one year, or both, in addition shall forfeit his office."

# RESOLUTION NO. 15-19 OCEAN COUNTY MUNICIPAL JOINT INSURANCE FUND RESOLUTION TO RENEW MUNICIPAL EXCESS LIABILITY JOINT INSURANCE FUND

WHEREAS, the Ocean County Municipal Joint Insurance Fund, a nonprofit public entity in the State of New Jersey, was formed pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:10-36 et seq. to provide risk management to its member municipalities in the form of General Liability, Auto Liability, Property and Workers' Compensation coverage; and

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined that excess coverage is available from the Municipal Excess Liability Joint Insurance Fund, hereinafter referred to as MEL, as established pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:10-36 et seq., provided in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:10-42; and

**WHEREAS**, the purchase of such coverage by the MEL is exempt from public advertising and bidding requirements pursuant to  $\underline{N.J.S.A.}$  40A:11-5(1)(a)(ii) and 40A:11-5(1)(m) as an extraordinary unspecifiable service ("EUS") so long as the contract entered into is awarded in accordance with the requirements for EUSs; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A:65-14, the governing bodies of two or more Local Units may enter into an agreement to provide for the formation of the joint operation of any public services, public improvements, works, facilities, or undertakings which the local units are empowered to operate; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:65-9 et seq. the MEL shall obtain coverage on behalf of its members JIFs in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law; and

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A:10-36 <u>et seq.</u>, a JIF wishing to join the MEL to obtain the benefits of joint public entity membership may do so by adopting a resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Fund Commissioners of the Ocean County Municipal Joint Insurance Fund has determined that membership in the MEL is in the best interests of the member municipalities:

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Fund Commissioners of the **Ocean County Municipal Joint Insurance Fund** does hereby resolve and agree to renew membership in the MEL for a period of three (3) years, the commencement of which shall be July 1, 2019 and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the application for membership is for the purpose of obtaining the following types of coverages:

- 1) Excess Workers' Compensation and Employers' Liability Insurance and,
- 2) Excess Liability Insurance excess of the Primary Liability provided by the

- above mentioned Joint Insurance Fund as indicated on the application previously submitted and,
- 3) Excess Property, including Crime.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the **Ocean County Municipal Joint Insurance Fund** hereby adopts the Bylaws of the MEL and in accordance therewith, it is understood that coverage is not effective until membership is approved by the MEL Commissioners/Executive Committee, State Department of Banking & Insurance and State Department of Community Affairs and that coverage is subject to the terms, conditions and limitations as contained in the MEL's Coverage Manual and its Commercial Excess Insurance, if any; and,

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Board of Fund Commissioners, or other authorized representative, is authorized and directed to execute any and all written agreements necessary for membership in the MEL including, but not limited to, the Indemnity and Trust Agreement in order to implement membership by the **Ocean County Municipal Joint Insurance Fund** in the MEL according to its Bylaws, N.J.S.A. 40A:10-36 et seq., N.J.A.C. 11:15-2 and any other statutes or regulations pertaining thereto.
