THE ORDER OF THE FRIENDLY SONS OF THE SHILLELAGH OLD BRIDGE, NJ

CLUB HISTORY VOLUME #1

Right lads here we go, our first letter in to begin the history of our club as we prepare for the celebration of our "Golden 50th Anniversary". Now before I go any further, I want you all to take into account that this gentleman is trying to remember back nearly 50 years ago. We all know some of us can't even remember what we had for breakfast ;-). So give him credit for the memories, as I truly do. Soooo off we go...

In January, 1964, Jack Dunphy and Harry Knox thought about getting a group together to March in the Newark, St. Patrick's Day Parade. Then one night at the Spotswood Bowling alley, Bobby Trachman came to us guys bowling in the league and said there was a meeting in the back room after bowling. We thought it was about bowling, but it was about marching in the St. Patrick's Day Parade. A bunch of us agreed that we would like to march.

A meeting was held at Pete's Pizza on Main St. in Old Bridge to discuss the plans of how we were going to do this. It was decided we would all rent tuxedo's. Harry Knox made arrangements through a "Parade Committee".

We left on Sunday morning, March 15th 1964, 40 proud Irishmen by bus from the Turf Club on route 9 in Old Bridge for our first St. Patrick's Day Parade in Newark. Before we marched, we choose a name for ourselves from "The Jackie Gleason Show", but we did not make it official until after the parade. We wrote to Jackie Gleason Studios for permission to name our club "The Order of the Friendly Sons of the Shillelagh". They responded "OK" and that's how we got our name.

Then we met monthly in clubs and restaurants in Old Bridge, like the American Legion, the old St. Thomas Hall and the Turf Club. We then sought to purchase the land. One Sunday morning we went to Oak Street and walked through the grounds, the water came up to our knees.

Names to be remembered from the early days...Harry Knox, Bobby Trachman, Jack Dunphy, Mike Ruffley and Tom Murphy.

I cannot remember everyone, but the work crew mostly consisted of Shillelagh Brother's, with all their talents. I cannot tell you how we got some of our materials... "We Irish are very resourceful"!!

So this all led to Jackie Gleason's favorite words..." AND AWAY WE GO!!"

Thank you to one of our Founding Members, Mr. Barney Shannon, for what he recalls from memory.

Remember... "We Irish are the best story tellers", so keep them coming lads. – John P. Sheridan.


