
Saturday, June 10 - Next Month's Pre-Pig Roast Work Party @ 9:00am

Saturday, June 10 - Annual Pig Roast @ 1pm

This is our greatest outdoor event. Aside from roasted swine, there will be Clams, deep-fried Turkey, Sausage & Peppers, Burgers, Hot Dogs, homemade coleslaw, potato and pasta salads, etc. Food features include smoked ribs and corn-on-the-cob, cooked on the grill. Deserts of cake and melon will also be served. Arrive with an empty stomach. And yes, there will be BEER and wine (ID required), and lemonade and punch for the kids.

Tickets are \$25 per person for those 21 and over. But, if purchased by June 3rd, you get the early bird price of \$20. Purchase a block of 10 tickets by June 3rd, you not only get the \$20 per person price, but you also get a reserved picnic table under the Pavilion. Our goal is to sell as many tickets prior to the event, so we can forecast the amount of food needed.


