THIS MONTH IN IRISH HISTORY

August 16 thru 22, 2017 – the 58th annual 'Rose of Tralee International Festival", one of Ireland largest festivals, will be held in Tralee, Co. Kerry, Ireland.

August 21, 1879 – At 8pm on a rainy night in the village of Knock, Co. Mayo, 15 people witnessed an Apparition of Our Lady, St. Joseph, St. John the Evangelist, a lamb and cross, on an altar at the gable wall of their Parish Church. The site is now called Ireland's National Marian Shrine, and every year, tens of thousands of visitors make a pilgrimage to the Knock Shrine.

August 22, 1922 – During the Irish Civil War, the Irish National Army's commander-in-chief, Michael Collins, was assassinated in an ambush while travelling through the village of Béal na mBláth, County Cork. His funeral was the largest funeral procession ever held.
