Originally called 'Armistice Day', it was a worldwide anniversary, celebrating the signing of an Armistice, signaling the end of World War I, which took effect on the 11th hour, of the 11th day, of the 11th month, of 1918. Every year thereafter, each country commemorated the Armistice their own way.

On May 13, 1938, the U.S. Congress created a permanent national holiday called 'Armistice Day' to honor the deceased soldiers of WWI, and declared that every November 11th would be the official legal holiday.

On June 1, 1954, the U.S. Congress amended the original Congressional Act by replacing the word 'Armistice" with the word "Veterans" and, also modified it to include all U.S. Veterans, alive or deceased, from all wars, not just WWI. Veterans Day is celebrated across the U.S. with memorials, parades and military ceremonies. On behalf of the FSOS and their families, we thank all members, past and present, for their service in the Air Force, Army, Coast Guard, Marine and Navy.

Card Access System

The new Card Access System is operational; old access cards no longer work! If you have not picked up your new card or FOB, see Jeff Schuld, Tim Black or Jamie O'Kane.

All non-member guests over 21 years old MUST sign the Guestbook at the door; this is a requirement of our State of NJ liquor license.

If you are the last person to leave the building at night, turn off the lights, CHECK ALL DOORS to confirm they are locked; deadbolt the front door; and then drop the key into the mail slot.

Monthly AD Book - New Payment Program

The monthly AD Book is one of the revenue streams we count on to keep the Club running. Therefore, we are changing the way we sell the AD Book tickets and collect the money for the monthly drawings. Our yearly goal is to have all 300 AD Book tickets sold and paid for. If we don't sellout the 300 tickets, we will target a lower quantity, which will result in a lower monthly payout.

Starting with the March 2018 meeting and going forward, all AD Book tickets will be sold as a 1-year subscription (i.e. \$60 per calendar year) and must be paid in full for the year, at the March meeting. Please note: before you can purchase an AD Book ticket(s), you must pay any AD Book money owed from previous years.

Beginning with the April 2018 meeting, AD Book money will no longer be collected, nor will individual tickets be sold at any meeting!!! If you do not pay in full in March, you will lose your ticket(s) and must wait until the following year to get back in; but there's no guarantee your ticket(s), or any ticket will be available.

Also, to re-obtain a ticket you will be required to pay any outstanding unpaid balance owed, based upon the quantity of tickets and number of months the ticket(s) were in your possession, if applicable.

We understand that many members have tickets, and/or specific numbers they want to keep, which is why we are notifying everyone 5 months in advance, so you can properly budget and place money aside. This way, when March 2018 arrives you will be able to pay in full.

Please note: If you are a member in good standing, and have a large quantity of tickets, speak to Jeff Schuld or Dennis Pinkiewicz, and they will try to work with **you.**

Finally, all future incoming members will be asked and encouraged to purchase an available AD Book ticket once they are a member. If no tickets are available, we will begin a waiting list.
