PARADE DAY INFORMATION

2018 Belmar/Lake Como Parade Adjutant

Congratulations to Mr. Robert Hobson, who was selected to be our 2018 Belmar / Lake Como Parade Adjutant, in recognition of his many years of commitment to this club. Bob is well deserving of this honor.

This will be the 32nd Anniversary of marching in the Belmar / Lake Como Parade!

All Members are required to march: If for any reason you cannot march, you must submit a written note to the Executive Board, prior to Parade Day, requesting to be excused. Automatic excuses are not given due to non-residency, work, etc. Those who do not submit a request, or do not sign-in, WILL receive a censure.

Uniform Information: Full FSOS uniforms must be worn on Parade Day. Uniform consists of gray dress slacks, white dress shirt and black shoes, which you acquire from any clothing store. The Uniform components are the green Blazer; jacket FSOS patch; FSOS neck-tie; beret and FSOS hat broach, which are available from TRIPLE CROWN SPORTS (TCS); see the TCS Ad in this newsletter for location. Visit the store to acquire everything prior to Parade Day, especially if you have a request for a special size blazer or beret.

Parade Day Etiquette:

Gentlemen, ensure your uniform is clean & pressed, and black shoes are polished (NO black sneakers). Limit any accessory to those in good taste. If you have a question on something you would like to wear, please check with the Parade Adjutant, President, or Marshals. You must step-off the parade with the club; you are not permitted to jump in or out of the line if we pass any taverns you may be interested in. Smoking and drinking are prohibited during the parade. Our Parade Marshals will take note of any transgression. Proper conduct is expected before, during, and especially after the parade.

DO NOT embarrass the Friendly Sons Organization, or yourself; you represent the finest Irish-American Club in the world. You may be censured for any transgression!

2018 FSOS CLUB DUES

If you have not paid your 2018 Club Fees, you are late!! Write separate checks for your Dues (\$100, or \$25 for members over 65 with the required time), AD-Book (\$60 - see article within this newsletter concerning the new payment structure), and Building Fund (\$50). NO lump sum payment checks please; that usually leads to confusion, and is an accounting nightmare. Put your checks in one envelope, and drop into safe. Make it easy on our Treasurer and pay on time.

MONTHLY AD BOOK - NEW PAYMENT PROGRAM

The monthly AD Book is one of the revenue streams we count on to keep the Club operating.

Starting with the March meeting and going forward, we have decided to change the way we sell, and collect the money, for the monthly AD Book tickets. Our goal is to have all 300 AD Book tickets sold and paid for, by March of every year. If we can't sellout the 300 tickets, we may be forced to target a lower quantity, which will result in a lower monthly payout.

All AD Book tickets will be sold as a 1-year subscription (i.e. \$60) and **must be paid in full, at the March meeting**. However, before you can purchase any AD Book ticket(s), you must pay for any AD Book money owed from previous months or years.

Beginning with the April meeting, AD Book tickets will NO longer be sold at any meeting, nor will money be collected!!! If you have not paid in full at the March meeting, you lose your ticket(s), and must wait until the following year to get back in; and there's no guarantee your ticket(s), or any ticket will be available.

Also, to re-obtain a ticket you will be required to pay any outstanding unpaid balance, based upon the quantity of tickets and number of months the ticket(s) which were in your possession, if applicable.

We understand that many members have tickets, and/or specific numbers they want to keep, which is why we are notifying everyone 5 months in advance, so you can properly budget and place money aside. This way, when March 2018 arrives you will be able to pay in full.

If you are a member in good standing, and have a large quantity of tickets, speak to Jeff Schuld or Dennis Pinkiewicz, and they will try to work with you.

Finally, all future new members will be offered, and encouraged, to purchase any unsold AD Book ticket. If no tickets are available, we will begin a waiting list.
