Beautification of the Main Bar

The Building Committee was tasked with preparing an *extremely preliminary plan* to partially upgrade the main bar. At the June meeting, the president presented their concept to the membership. The concept is to strip all the walls of the old wood paneling (circa 1960's), and replace with a two-tier replacement wall, ie: wood paneling up to about 4 feet, with brickwork above it to the ceiling; remove and re-use the perimeter finned-radiation (FTR) and install at ground level, instead of the current height; hide the hot water risers feeding the FTR; and perform any necessary electrical work as needed.

As this upgrade is in the early development stage, any dollar value discussed is non-factual until an agreement on the design is reached; then we will get actual quotes. Once quotes are received, the plan and costs will be submitted to the membership. The bar, floor, ceiling tiles, nor anywhere outside the bar, ie., foyer, kitchen, lounge or main hall, will be modified. We will keep you abreast of all discussions as they proceed, but you need to attend the meetings when further discussions are scheduled.

During the July meeting, the first reading was made, and after some discussions, a motion was made to proceed with a not-to-exceed dollar value. It was approved via a majority hand vote.

During the August meeting, a second reading was made and the motion to proceed was approved via a majority hand vote. At the upcoming September meeting, the third and final reading will occur, and a final hand vote will be taken. Be there to voice your concerns or approval.


