Assignment #4: Draw this SECTION DUE by email SUNDAY 10/5/12 at 9pm.

You should have a pretty accurate 1/2" groundplan of the HERE now. Good job.

Now you need to draw a section. **TWO actually.** Remember how? Do a section that cuts the theatre North/South. Make what you think is the Centerline and indicate it on your Groundplan. Draw this section (facing East). But ALSO draw a section that starts just in front of the audience....it will be like an Elevation of the North Wall.

These are all the important measurements and then some other pertinent info:

Height from floor to grid: 11'-2 1/2"

Height from floor to ceiling: 12'6"

height of airduct on west wall: 1'9 3/4"

Distance from below airduct to floor: 9'4"

There is a window on the North wall that has been bricked over, but is still dimensional:

It is 9'-0" high and starts 2'10" from the stage floor

The first riser is 12" high and all others are in 6" increments.

Doors are all 6'9" high.

The North wall is Brick. The East wall is drywall. Please indicate this in your drawing.

Format for a 24x36". INCLUDE A TITLEBLOCK. This is a real theatre. Use the address.
