


**WELCOME TO THE SHRINE of OUR LADY**

**Transfiguration of Our Lord - AUGUST 6, 2017 - Transfiguration of Our Lord**

**COLLECTION** - We thank those Parishioners who support our Parish with their treasure, talent and time.

**IMPORTANT DATES** - August 15th - Feast of the Assumption. High Mass at 6 PM. September 14th, Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross, marks the Tenth Anniversary of Summorum Pontificum. October 13th - 100th Anniversary of the last Apparition of Our Lady at Fatima. High Mass, Procession and reception, starting at 6 PM. Saturday, Oct. 14th - 10 AM at Seville Square, the annual Rosary Rally. Mark your calendars! Legion of Mary Retreat on November 10-12.

**SPECIAL FUND** - In conjunction with the Diocese a special tax free fund has been set up to help defray the cost of re-roofing the Rectory and the Garage attached. New estimates have lowered the cost significantly. It will still cost about \$45K. The Diocese is starting us off with \$5K. If everyone donates a bit, as much as you can we can raise enough and not have to borrow. Let us get this done. It will be a 20 year roof. Most of us will not have to worry about the next one. Please help!

**HOSPITALS** - We remind all that nowadays the hospitals or other healthcare providers do not call the Parish to let us know if you are there. YOU or someone in your family must be the one to notify Father. If you know of an upcoming surgery please make sure to get to Confession and ask Father to anoint you BEFORE the procedure. This is very important.

**TITHING** - Even if you are away on vacation or for some other reason, you are reminded that our Parish still has its bills and other obligations to pay. In your charity, please make up for your absence before or after, so we can keep our obligations. Thank you!

**SPECIAL NEED** - In addition to all else, one of the AC units of the Parish Hall died this past month. It was last replaced after hurricane Ivan in 2004. The new one will cost \$5K. Please remember this when making your contributions each week. Thank-you!

**FUNERALS** - Everyone is recommended to write down your funeral instructions and give a copy to Rev. Father and to your children or other caretaker(s). Many who even have gone to daily Mass and Communion have been denied a Catholic Funeral by their fallen away children or relatives. Do not put this in your will. That is read after you are buried. Once the caretakers take over Father can do nothing unless you have expressed your desires for your Funeral. Very important!

**RECEPTION** - There will be a small reception after the High Mass on August 20th, to bid Seminarist, Aaron Zanca, farewell as he goes to the Seminary

**ACT OF CONTRITION**

Many do not know that there are actually two different ways of saying the Act of Contrition: one inside the Confessional before receiving Absolution; another at any other time, especially when going to bed or other occasions. Other than frequent (at least monthly) confession all should practice the particular examen each day and night and beg pardon of God for offenses committed.

O my God, I am heartily sorry for having offended Thee, and I detest all my sins because of Thy just punishments (some say: the loss of Heaven and the pains of Hell), but most of all because they offend Thee, my God, Who art all good and deserving of all my love. I firmly resolve with the help of Thy grace to sin no more and to avoid the near occasion of sin. Amen.

*Outside the Confessional*

O my God, I am heartily sorry for having offended Thee, and I detest all my sins because of Thy just punishments (the loss of Heaven and the pains of Hell), but most of all because they offend Thee, my God, Who art all good and deserving of all my love. I firmly resolve with the help of Thy grace to confess my sins, do penance, and amend my life. Amen.
