IMPORTANT DATES - THIS TUESDAY, August 15th - Feast of the Assumption. Mass in English at 8 AM, High Mass at 6 PM. September 14th, Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross, marks the Tenth Anniversary of Summorum Pontificum. October 13th - 100th Anniversary of the last Apparition of Our Lady at Fatima. High Mass, Procession and reception, starting at 6 PM. Saturday, Oct. 14th - 10 AM at Seville Square, the annual Rosary Rally. Mark your calendars! Legion of Mary Retreat on November 10-12.

TITHING - Even if you are away on vacation or for some other reason, you are reminded that our Parish still has its bills and other obligations to pay. In your charity, please make up for your absence before or after, so we can keep our obligations. Thank you!

HOLY DAY - This Tuesday, August 15th, is the Solemn Feast of the Assumption of Mary, body and soul, into Heaven. It is a Holy Day of Obligation and ALL Catholics are obliged under penalty of mortal sin to assist at Holy Mass. Masses here will be in English at 8 AM and a High Mass in the Gregorian Rite at 6 PM.

HOSPITALS - We remind all that nowadays the hospitals or other healthcare providers do not call the Parish to let us know if you are there. YOU or someone in your family must be the one to notify Father. If you know of an upcoming surgery please make sure to get to Confession and ask Father to anoint you BEFORE the procedure. This is very important.

FUNERALS - Everyone is recommended to write down your funeral instructions and give a copy to Rev. Father and to your children or other caretaker(s). Many who even have gone to daily Mass and Communion have been denied a Catholic Funeral by their fallen away children or relatives. Do not put this in your will. That is read after you are buried. Once the caretakers take over Father can do nothing unless you have expressed your desires for your Funeral. Very important!

Fatima and the Devotion to the Immaculate Heart of Mary



Prayers and sacrifices for poor sinners, the recitation of the Holy Rosary, Hell and war, offenses against God and His Mother, secrets to be revealed later, announcement of wars, conversion of Russia and a miracle to come -- all these things attracted nearly 100,000 persons to Fatima on October 13, 1917. In front of this immense crowd, after a heavy rain which left everyone muddy and tired, the sun danced. They were witnesses of this unique miracle, never seen before. Between 1925 and 1930, Sister Lucia Dos Santos continued to receive instructions to complete and transmit the message and the secrets. The first and second World Wars would start and finish as prophesied by the Queen of Peace.

"Jesus wants to use you in order to make me known and loved. He wants to establish in the world the devotion to my Immaculate Heart. To the one who embraces it, I promise salvation. These souls will be loved by God as flowers picked by me to adorn His throne....My heart will be your refuge and the way which will lead you to God." Thus devotion to the Immaculate Heart of Mary appears to be the very core of the revelations at Fatima.
