Building Renovation Grant Application

### Philmont Beautification, Inc. can provide 50% matching grant funds to renovate your building through its NY Main Street Revitalization Program.

#### Eligible buildings can receive:

Up to \$50,000 for Interior Building and Façade building renovation costs for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> floors of civic/commercial buildings, and up to \$25,000 per unit for LI program eligible rental unit renovations not to exceed 75% of the total project cost. (up to a maximum of \$150,000 of total renovation costs)

#### If you own:

- a mixed-use business property
- a residential low-income rental property
- a historic property that has experienced extensive neglect
- a property that could provide renovated storefronts on Main Street

The Philmont Beautification, Inc. NY Main Street Program aims to help revitalize buildings located in the downtown business section of Philmont Village. We seek buildings that have experienced sustained physical deterioration, decay, neglect, or disinvestment, and are located in a concentrated area of 2 to 3 blocks that have a number of substandard buildings or vacant residential or commercial units.
