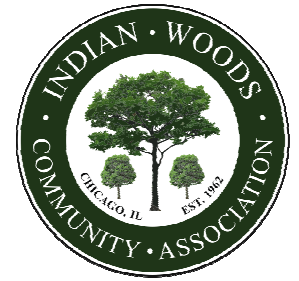

DEAR ALDERMAN LEVAR:

THE INDIAN WOODS COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION (IWCA) HAD A SPECIAL GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING ON SATURDAY, JULY 10, 2010, REGARDING THE ABOVE AFOREMENTIONED SUBJECT MATTER.

MR. THOMAS R. TRIER, THE APPLICANT OF THE ESTABLISHMENT PERMIT, THE CHICAGO POLICE DEPARTMENT, AND YOUR OFFICE WERE INVITED.

PRESENTATIONS FROM IWCA DIRECTORS, THE APPLICANT, AND OTHER GUEST WERE GIVEN TO THE IWCA MEMBERSHIP IN ATTENDANCE. IWCA MEMBERS AND GUEST FROM OTHER COMMUNITIES WERE GIVEN THE OPPORTUNITY TO ASK QUESTIONS AND GIVE THEIR CONCERNS AND OPINIONS REGARDING THE PROPOSED ESTABLISHMENT TO MR. TRIER, GUEST, AND THE IWCA BOARD OF DIRECTORS.

AN ASSOCIATION VOTE BY MEMBERS OF THE IWCA AFTER THE PRESENTATIONS WAS TAKEN TO APPROVE OR DISAPPROVE THE PERMIT AS A COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION. THE RESULT OF THE COMMUNITY VOTE BY IWCA MEMBERS WAS AS FOLLOWS:

- (10) APPROVED THE TAVERN ESTABLISHMENT PERMIT
- (15) DISAPPROVED THE TAVERN ESTABLISHMENT PERMIT
- (9) DID NOT VOTE (ABSTAINED)

PLEASE NOTE THE RESULTS OF THE ABOVE VOTE WERE BY IWCA MEMBERS WHO LIVE IN THE ENTIRE COMMUNITY SERVICE AREA. HOMEOWNERS LIVING WITHIN THE 250-FOOT RANGE OF THE PROPOSED ESTABLISHMENT WERE IN ATTENDANCE AND WERE NOTIFIED OF THEIR RIGHT TO PROVIDE THE CITY OF CHICAGO WRITTEN COMMENTS ON THEIR APPROVAL/DISAPPROVAL OF THE PERMIT AND THE ESTABLISHMENT OPERATION.
