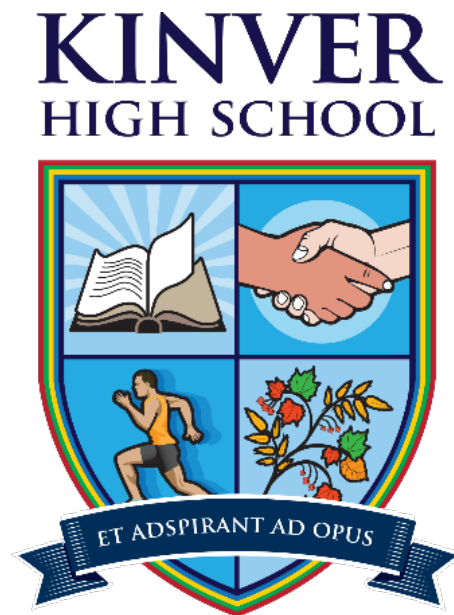

Rewards Policy

1 Positive Behaviour

Positive behaviour is recognised and rewarded at Kinver High School.

2 Rewards

Positive behaviour will be rewarded with the appropriate reward from those listed below, in the professional opinion of the member of staff issuing the reward:

- Verbal Praise
- Positive Constructive Feedback
- Certificates/Prizes for good work
- Certificates for punctuality and attendance
- Letters, Postcards or texts home reflecting good work or effort
- Headteacher Commendations
- Student of the half term (subject based)
- Special responsibilities/privileges regarding classroom leadership and supporting students
- Points awarded on Edge for events in accordance with the values set out at Appendix 1
- Positive award on a student's "strike card" for positive behaviour in a public area of school

3 Monitoring arrangements

This policy will be reviewed by the headteacher and local governing board annually, or sooner if there is a necessary change to behaviour management procedures within school.
