#### **How to Get SOX Certified**

SOX Institute offers two levels of (individual) SOX certifications which recognize your knowledge of and/or experience with SOX:

- SOXBase-level (Certified in Sarbanes-Oxley or CSOX®)
- SOXPro-level (Certified SOX Professional, or CSOXP®)

# Requirements for $SOXBase^{TM}$ :

- A minimum of 16 hours' SOX Institute's training above, and
- Current membership of SOX Institute (the GRC Group), and
- *Either*: One 'SOX 404' multiple-choice open-textbook exam proctored by a class facilitator if attending the class training. *Or*: Two multiple-choice open-textbook exams proctored by a supervisor at work if taking self-study (online or textbook).

### Requirements for $SOXPro^{TM}$ :

- An active, valid and current SOXBase-level certification, and
- An average of at least 1,200 hours of SOX/related experience in the prior 3 years as verifiable by 2 professional references.

#### *Maintaining Certifications:*

- Annual membership of SOX Institute (the GRC Group) and
- Experience requirements specified above for SOXPro-level.

**DAY 1:** Fundamentals of Sarbanes-Oxley (8 CPE/CPD) **Program level:** Basic. **Preparation/prerequisite:** None.

*Objective*: Broad-based introduction to the legislation's key tenets, as well as industry-accepted frameworks and principles such as COSO, COBIT, ITIL and ISO.

Agenda: Effectively broken out into ~2-hour segments, Day One is an interactive seminar-style presentation on SOX and its frameworks.

The timings are approximate and may vary depending on classroom discussion. The day is divided into four approximately 2-hour quarters.

Quarter 1: Introduction to Sarbanes-Oxley including:

- Sustaining cost-effective compliance

Quarter 2: Key Sections and Titles of SOX such as:

- Audit Committees, Auditor Independence
- CEO/CFO Responsibility and Certification
- Financial Disclosures, Internal Controls
- Conflicts of Interest, Codes of Conduct
- Whistleblower Protection, Corporate Fraud
- White-Collar Crime Penalties, and more

Quarter 3: Introduction to COSO ERM Components:

- Internal Environment
- Objective Setting
- Event Identification
- Risk Assessment
- Risk Response
- Control Activities
- Info/Communication
- Monitoring



Quarter 4: Introduction to Specialized Frameworks:

- Control Objectives for IT (COBIT)
- IT Infrastructure Library (ITIL)
- International Standards (ISO)
- Auditing Standards (AS)

*DAY 2:* SOX Section **404** Documentation (8 CPE/CPD) *Program Level:* Basic. *Prep/Pre-reqs:* None required.

*Objective:* Gain practical hands-on experience with SOX Section 404 documentation of internal controls based on COSO and IT templates provided on CD.

*Agenda:* Using hands-on case-studies and classroom exercises, the day is spent learning best practices for COSO/IT internal control documentation including:

- Adequacy of Existing Documentation
- Entity-Level Policies and Procedures
- Activity-Level Control Procedures
- IT/Infrastructure Control Policies
- Automated Compliance Tools
- Working with Independent Auditors

- Activity-Level Operating Effectiveness
- Documenting Test Procedures and Results

DAY 4: SOX Sec 404 Project Management: 8 CPE/CPD Program Level: Advanced. Prep/Pre-reqs: None.

*Objective:* Understand the "big-picture" of SOX 404 compliance wrapping up Days 2 and 3, and including:

- Project Scoping for Entity and Activity
- Identifying Significant Accounts
- Project Lifecycle Management
- Structuring the Project Team
- Documenting Planning Decisions
- Sustaining Cost-Effective Compliance

*DAY 5:* SOX Review (4 CPE/CPD) Certification Exam *Program Level:* Update. *Prep/Pre-reqs:* None required.

*Objective:* Review of key aspects covered in Days 1-4 in preparation for the SOX Certification Examination.
