Here are a few words of wisdom, sage bits of advice,
and handy instructions to get you on your way:


General instructions:

1. Instruct your printer to print only those pages you want. This page is 1 of 3--my spectacular copywriting skills notwithstanding, there's probably no need to print this one!
2. If your printer is capable of borderless printing, be sure that your printer is **not** set to scale the image -- otherwise the proportions of your card may be off. If you do not have a printer with borderless capabilities, let your printer use its default scaling--you'll have to trim some edges, but that's no biggie, right?

3. Print! (You should use card stock for the cards. If you want to use the envelopes or wrapping paper, I recommend a text or writing weight paper.)


For the cards:

1. Cut the page in half height-wise (5.5" from either side).
2. Fold each card in half width-wise (4.25" from either side). **For flat cards, cut along the width-wise line.
3. Enjoy! Go ahead, pat yourself on the back. Wipe the sweat from your brow. You earned it.




For the envelope:

1. Cut around the printed shape, leaving no border.
2. Fold each flap toward the center of the envelope, creasing at each corner intersection (this is easier to do than explain!).
3. Run a bead of glue along the edge of the two short side flaps, and press the long back flap up to meet them.
4. Use glue, tape, or a sticker to seal your envelope!
