

NUHW MEMBERS VOTE BY 94% TO REJECT MANAGEMENT'S OFFER

Last week, Doctor's Medical Center Administration made what they referred to as a "final proposal" to the NUHW Bargaining Team. This proposal was the first time that Managements wage and retiree health proposals were actually put in writing.

On Wednesday October 17th NUHW members at Doctors Medical voted overwhelmingly to reject managements offer which included only 1 percent in pay increases every 6 months and increases in health insurance costs.
