

## Village of Granville Provides Tree Maintenance for Village Owned Trees

The Granville Village Service Department (GSD) provides maintenance for Village owned trees located in public rights-of-way. The tree maintenance program consists of pruning, shaping, cabling and removing deadwood from existing trees. When necessary, due to age, decay, or unsafe conditions, GSD removes such trees. Before any tree is removed, Granville Service Department confers with the Tree and Landscape Commission and contacts adjacent property owners explaining the need to remove a specific tree. The Tree and Landscape Commission plants all new trees, and the Granville Service Department performs all maintenance and stump removals. At the present time, the Granville Service Department's goal is to provide maintenance to each Village tree on a seven-year systematic tree maintenance cycle. The Tree and Landscape Commission meets in Village Hall Council Chambers the second Tuesday of each month.
