Some of Queensland's finest young musicians will feature in this concert including Matthew White who will play Vaughan Williams' dynamic *Tuba Concerto* (1st movement). Trumpeter George Wilson is also on the bill along with viola player Jacob Seabrook, violinist Audrich Allen, Brisbane pianist Julian Wade and Cellist Isabella McDonald, who will be playing Astor Piazzolla's *Le Grand Tango*.

These concerts have been going for four years now and are very popular and serve as introductions to some exciting young musicians as well as being wonderful escapes from the hurly burly of the week. And who could imagine a lovelier venue?
