



EDUCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP FACT SHEET

The Community Services Block Grant Scholarship is offered to a **graduating high school senior or another adult high school graduate or GED recipient**. Applicant must apply in the county where they reside, and be preparing for a career by enrolling or already enrolled in a post-secondary program, such as a college/university, vocational/technical school, or trade/professional school.

This year's scholarship will apply up to \$1,000 to direct costs such as tuition, books, laboratory equipment, course fees, or student housing incurred by curriculum requirements. Entrance fee to guarantee pre-registration is NOT an eligible cost.

There are no restrictions of career choice.

All completed applications must be submitted to your Guidance Counselor, Youth Service Center Coordinator or Community Action County Coordinator by the **30th** day of **March, 2013**. Household income for applicants must be at or below 125% of the Federal Poverty Income Guidelines. (Please see attached.)

Scholarship winners will be contacted to schedule an Awards Presentation with the local Judge Executive and/or Board Member. A news release with permission of applicant will also be placed in the local newspaper.

Scholarship proceeds are paid to vendors only.
