Programs and Services

Access to Visitation

Provides support and facilitates non-custodial parents' access to and visitation of their children. Services include *Supervised Visitation, Therapeutic Monitoring, and Neutral Drop Off/Pick-Up.*

Child Care Centers

Provide a clean and safe environment for age appropriate education in a learning through play environment with caring, trained staff and nutritious meals. Centers in Bowling Green and Edmonton.

***Community Collaborations
for Children***

Provides In Home Services and Parenting Classes for families to prevent child abuse or neglect and enhance family well-being. A Regional Network plans and coordinates community initiatives to address local needs.

Community Services

Provides individual and community services to address the causes and conditions of poverty. Services administered in 7 areas: employment, education, housing, self-sufficiency, emergency services (food, rent, utilities), community participation and economic development.

Food Service

Provides a unified food service for Head Start, child care centers, and summer food service. The Food Service operation is a full participant in the United States Department of Agriculture Child and Adult Care Food Program.

Foster Grandparent Program

Provides senior citizens 55 years or older the opportunity to give guidance and one-on-one attention for children and youth who have special or exceptional needs. Senior participants receive many benefits, including a stipend for income-eligible volunteers.

Head Start

Provides a comprehensive child development program for eligible three and four year old children and their families; school readiness preparation including education, health, nutrition, social, special needs and parent involvement.



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Kynector

Provides education and enrollment assistance to individuals, families, and small businesses, enabling them to make informed decisions when selecting and enrolling in health plans on the Kentucky Health Benefit Exchange, including Medicaid and the Kentucky Children's Health Insurance Program (KCHIP).

Low-Income Home Energy Assistance (LIHEAP Program)

Provides assistance to income-eligible households with home heating cost through two components:

Subsidy provides one-time direct payment to household's home energy provider.

Crisis provides assistance to households in home energy crisis.

Refugee Services Provides case management and employment services for eligible refugees and other qualifying immigrants residing in the United States less than five (5) years. Services focus on encouraging community integration and self-sufficiency.

Retired and Senior Volunteers (RSVP)

Volunteers age 55 and older involved in this program serve in areas of health, safety, children's services, senior services, disaster preparedness and other community needs in Allen, Barren, Logan, Simpson and Warren counties.

Senior Centers

Provide activities and services designed to aid in the social and nutritional well being of our senior citizens age 60 and older. Meals, transportation, recreation, health, nutrition and enrichment activities.

Supportive Housing

Assists homeless individuals and families to achieve residential stability, increase their skill levels and/or income and obtain greater self-determination.

Transportation

Provides limited transportation services for Head Start and Senior Centers.



GO bg Transit provides public transit services in the City of Bowling Green.

Weatherization

Provides eligible homeowners and renters with home improvements to achieve healthier, safer and more energy-efficient homes.
