



## *Important Reminders for Observing Practice at Lake Forest Academy*

Lake Forest Academy is a private boarding school and places a very high priority of the safety of the students and maintaining appropriate buffers between user groups like LFSC and the students. We have agreed to work to maintain appropriate buffers as protections for both LFA and LFSC. It's a growing sign of the times that facilities and outside user groups have these agreements for the mutual benefit of everyone.

Please observe the following at all practices and activities at Lake Forest Academy ...

**We are allowed into the building approximately 15 minutes prior to the start of each scheduled practice.** Our coaches cannot open the building any earlier and generally remain in their cars if they do arrive early.

Parking at LFA is limited and gets very crowded if there is a campus activity or sports event. Plan to drop off 15 minutes prior to practice.

**The locker rooms are reserved for LFA teams and students until 7:30pm every night.** This maintains the buffer between their students and our members who are generally under HS age. At no time are LFSC parents, siblings or other adults allowed in the locker rooms. LFSC swimmers must arrive in their suits and warm-ups and keep personal belongings in a backpack on deck.

Following practice our coaches will open the pool locker rooms for our swimmers to change. Please remember to pick up all equipment, toiletries and clothing, and use the trash cans!

**The viewing area immediately adjacent to the pool is the only area spectators and parents are allowed to wait.** We are not allowed into the foyer, hallways outside the locker rooms, hockey rink, or gymnasiums.

**All swimmers must be picked up within 15 minutes after the finish of practice.** Coach Laurel coaches and swims on the Libertyville Masters and has a very tight schedule to be on time. LFA expects all LFSC coaches and members to be off campus by 8:00pm nightly.

Please help us maintain the safety of all of our teammates and LFA students by observing these rules. And help us maintain a healthy relationship with the LFA administration by reminding each other of these obligations.
