Duties

As a volunteer interpreter, your duties may include:

- Providing language assistance during client-attorney meetings and interviews by telephone or in-person
- Translating written documents

Requirements

- Fluency in English and another language (Spanish preferred)
- Age 18+
- An interest in learning the basic skills of interpretation and translation (no professional experience required)
- Commitment to interpreters' ethics, including confidentiality, accuracy, impartiality, respect, cultural competency, and professionalism
- Flexible hours
- Experience working with people from diverse backgrounds
- Desire to support adults and children in immigration proceedings
- Proficient written communication skills
- Ability to meet deadlines and work in a timely fashion
- Access to transportation
- Must pass a federal background check and provide \$15 to RMIAN for processing of check
