

Totara Park Equestrian Centre Ground Rules

- Lock the front gate if you are the last one to leave or if riders are out in the park.
- Safety helmet and suitable footwear must be worn when mounted
- Groups have regular bookings each week. Check the calendar for more details www.tpec.org.nz
 - Adult Ride - Saturday 9am-12.30pm
 - Pony Club - Saturday 1.30 - 5pm
 - RDA - Monday and Thursday 8-2pm (during school term)
- Financial members of TPPC, TPARC and TPRDA are permitted on the property at all times unless there is a group booking
- There is no charge for family and friends occasionally riding a horse that grazes at TPEC (fair use policy applies)
- A responsible adult must supervise children (under 16) at all times.
- No loose horses
- Dogs must be on leash or tied up and no dogs allowed in the Yards
- Obscene language, inappropriate behaviour, excessive use of whips, spurs or aggressive horse handling techniques is not acceptable on these grounds
- Do not turn off electric fences (unless there is an event or fault which is then reported).
- Gates must be left as they are found
- Remove manure from arena, yards, pens, and driveway after use and put in the bins provided.
- Rake up hay/feed and dispose of, rake gravel level in pens before departure
- You may offload horses and gear by the yards but floats and trucks must be parked down the driveway
- Grazers have priority over covered yards for rallies and events
- Horses on trial are \$10.00 per night and this must be applied for through the grazing manager

Use of Arenas

- Horses are not permitted to be worked or jumped in paddocks where other horses are grazing - one of the two larger paddocks is usually free of grazing horses and available for these activities.
- If jumping, another person must be within visual contact and aware of the activity
- NO equipment is to be left out in the dressage arena. Some jumps may be left in the jumping arena
- Equipment used is to be stacked neatly by the gates or under clubrooms
- Be respectful when sharing spaces with others.
- All manure must be removed from the arena and round pen after use (put in the bins provided, not thrown over fences).
- Paid instructors outside group rallies must have their own insurance to teach on the grounds
