

Linda Gunter founded Beyond Nuclear in July 2007. She is the international specialist at Beyond Nuclear as well as the director of media and development. Linda's program focus is on industry bias in the media and on setting the record straight when facts are trumped by propaganda. In 2013, she researched and published a comprehensive white paper that debunked the many false positive myths about nuclear power pervasive in the media. She works year-round with the authors of the *World Nuclear Industry Status Report*, an independent analysis of global nuclear energy, using the empirical data in the report to correct misleading pro-nuclear assertions from politicians and the press.

Linda serves as a conduit to overseas partners and allies, with a particular focus on Germany and France. She also works occasionally on human rights and the uranium fuel chain and the nuclear power-nuclear weapons connection. She helps write and design many of the Beyond Nuclear publications and creates and produces short videos. She also manages the Beyond Nuclear website, Twitter, Facebook and YouTube presence. Linda is a former journalist and is a jury member for the internationally recognized Nuclear-Free Future Award. A former journalist from England, she has a BA Honours degree in English and Italian Literature from Warwick University. She speaks Italian, French, some Spanish and a smattering of German.
