Port Hope: A Case Study in Radioactive Risk and an insight on the privatization arrangements for managing nuclear waste disposal in Canada

Faye More, Chair of the Port Hope Community Health Concerns, will speak about radioactive contamination in Port Hope and the community's journey from realizing the extent of the widespread contamination through efforts to address it, including the federal government's decision to consolidate contaminated soil into a "mound" in Port Hope and continued issues and concerns, particularly in light of a recent proposal to relax environmental standards. by changing the radioactive waste cleanup criteria.





Theresa McClenaghan, Senior Counsel and Executive Director at the Canadian Environmental Law Association will speak about the privatization of radioactive waste management in Canada, with a special focus on the contractual arrangements between the federal government and the Canadian Nuclear Laboratories and CNL's owner /operator companies.
