

# Water Lily Dishcloth

## Supplies:

Size I/5.5 mm hook

Worsted weight cotton yarn in your choice of colors – I used Bernat Handicrafter in Creamsicle (A) and Hot Green (B). One 50g/1.75 ball of each color should make 2 cloths.

Gauge: not important. I tend to work tightly. My sample measured just over 7” wide.

Stitches used: sl st, sc, hdc, dc. Shell=5 dc in same sp.

Let's begin!

With color A:

Rnd 1: starting with a magic circle, 6 sc. Sl st to 1<sup>st</sup> st.

Rnd 2: ch 1; 2 sc in each st around. Join with sl st in 1<sup>st</sup> sc.

Rnd 3: \*ch 4; sk next st, sc in next st. Repeat from \* 4 more times. Ch2, dc in 1<sup>st</sup> ch of starting ch4.

Rnd 4: ch 1, sc in same loop. \*Work shell in next sc; sc in center of next loop. Repeat from \* around, ending with sl st in 1<sup>st</sup> sc.

Fasten off A. Join B with sl st in any sc between shells.

Rnd 5: ch 5, sc in 3<sup>rd</sup> dc of next shell. \*Ch 3, dc in next sc; ch 3, sc in 3<sup>rd</sup> dc. Repeat from \* around, ending with sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch of beginning ch 5.

Rnd 6: ch 1, sc in same st. 3 sc in next loop. \*Sc in sc; 3 sc in next loop. Sc in dc. Repeat from \* around, ending with sl st in 1<sup>st</sup> sc.

Rnd 7: ch 1, sc in same st. Sc in each st around. Join with sl st to 1<sup>st</sup> sc.

Rnd 8: ch 2, hdc in next st. \*2 hdc in next st, 1 hdc in next st. Repeat from \* around, ending with sl st in top of beginning ch 2.

Rnd 9: ch 1, sc in same sp. \*Sk next 2 st, shell in next st; sk next 2 st, sc in next st. Repeat from \* around, ending with sl st in 1<sup>st</sup> sc. Finish off. You're done!
