

## Free Crochet Pattern: Nubby Dishcloth

The great texture in this dishcloth is achieved by alternating single crochet and treble crochet stitches.

**Skill level:** easy

**Stitches used:** chain stitch (ch), single crochet (sc), treble crochet (tr).

**Gauge:** not important for this project. My finished cloth is about 7 ½" square.

### **Materials:**

- I used a 4mm/size G6 hook.
- 1 ball (1½ oz) worsted weight cotton. I used Bernat Handicrafter Cotton UltraSoft, Violet Veil Ombre.

### Pattern:

Row 1: Ch 26. Sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook and across. (25)

Row 2: Ch 1, turn. \* Sc in first st, tr in next. Repeat from \* across, ending with sc.

Row 3: Ch 3, turn. \* Sc in tr; tr in next sc. Repeat from \* across, ending with tr.

Row 4: Ch 1, turn. \* Sc in tr; tr in next sc. Repeat from \* across, ending with a sc in top of starting ch 3 of previous row.

Rows 5 to 23: Repeat rows 3 and 4, ending with a row 3. Do not fasten off.

Edging: Ch 1, turn. \* Sc across to next corner; 3 sc in last st. Repeat from \* around, ending with sl st into first sc. Fasten off and weave ends in.
