This program will be going out to over seventy-five churches in southern Mexico and will teach the children that it takes the Mighty Work of God in the Cross of Christ to save and justify us before the Lord. God continues to open doors for us to go and plant the seed of God's Word in the hearts of children in many different areas. Our whole second year class of the Full Time Program will be going out in the month of July for several weeks holding VBS in fifteen different churches. They received their materials and the complete program and training during our annual VBS Workshop for our Bible Students, teachers and VBS directors from churches of this region of southern Mexico. We had over 150 in attendance. The brethren from **Grace Bible Church in Olive Branch, MS** have been the providers for this complete program and materials for our students for almost twenty years. Led by pastor **Mark Webb**, a team from this church develops lessons, songs, dramas, crafts, games, and even refreshments that help teach the central lesson of God's Salvation by grace in the Lord Jesus Christ. During the workshop, Mark and several ladies from the church lead in this VBS training. Praise the Lord for this special blessing.

God allows MITC to provide housing, food and Biblical training for our Full Time Bible students free of monetary charge. It is a blessing of God's grace and love that we are able to give this. Many students come from remote regions and difficult financial situations that would make it impossible for them to attend if they were under financial obligations as in most schools. By grace we have received and by grace we give. God provides all this through the love of His children who support financially and also by those who come and provide for the needed maintenance and construction projects for the facility that houses all the MITC mission family (students and staff). God has graciously blessed us for over sixty years through the generosity of His children without any type of government funding or aid and without any certain denominational covering or program either. It is a testimony to the Love of God using individuals and individual churches that join with us in serving the Lord Jesus and His Gospel here at MITC. That is what keeps this work going day to day. All our programs of Bible Study (Full Time, Saturday Seminary, Local Bible Schools), our Christian Music School, Bible Conferences, Congresses, Workshops, Children Ministries etc., are all free of charge by the grace of God and His provision through His children. For this we are thankful and trust in the Lord for everything.

During the summer, we get to see some of our supporters face to face in visiting work groups from the United States. These teams are moved by God's love to come down with willing hands and hearts, and help us get many needed things done on campus and at other areas and churches and missions that need help. The **Grace Bible Church from Olive Branch, MS with Pastor Mark Webb** started our visiting groups of the summer and they jumped right in with a variety of projects: pouring concrete, building pews, welding, painting and sewing. During the week, Mark Webb and I had the privilege of attending the **Annual Assembly of the Berean Baptist Churches**, (our village churches in the mountains of Oaxaca). This year, the meeting was held in the mountain village of **Tejas**, among the **Chinanteco** speaking brethren. Mark was the preacher for the Bible Conference and he shared from the book of Thessalonians. Twenty years ago, Mark and I had been at this same village for this Assembly and had both ridden mules to make it up the mountains (our mules reportedly died within a week of our trip, giving their all for the ministry). Today, there is a dirt road so we were able to drive all the way to what was a mountain top experience in many ways. We had one very eventful day, starting out with steaming temperatures. Then around noon we had a hail storm, then a couple hours later, there was a swarming of flying ants in the whole village. Later that evening, there was an electrical storm and rushing wind so we felt we had a little taste of the plagues of Egypt. But no harm was done and we enjoyed the fellowship with the leaders from churches among the **Mixe, Chinanteco and Cuicateco tribes**, most of whom we have known for many years. It was a great blessing to be together.

Our next group was from **Shreveport**, a 55-person team led by **Cecil and Sissy Snider from Summer Grove and Northwoods Baptist Churches**. This team also helped us with painting, digging and helping pour a concrete entrance to our new VCM building. We also had the church pastors (**Aaron and Kevin** respectively) who came with their families and served preaching and in the work projects too. These brethren and their wives and kids were a great testimony to serving the Lord on missions. This group also had some special treats for the mission family. They prepared dinners of Jambalaya and fajitas...for many, it was the first time to taste the cooking from Louisiana. It was certainly a wonderful time of outpouring of God's love on our students and staff, as our brethren served us during this week.

Classes are coming to an end in a few more weeks in the Full Time program, the Saturday Seminary, the Local Bible School and the Christian Music School. The faculty continues faithfully teaching the Word of God each day and giving many useful ministerial tools to the students.

We give thanks to God for His Presence, Provision, Protection, and

Promise, all in and because of Jesus Christ our Lord. Thank you for serving with us through your prayers, support, visits and love in our Lord. God bless you.
