One of our graduates is **Alba**, who served last year during her "Year in Practice" (4<sup>th</sup> year) in the mountain region among the **Nahualt Indians** at the church of Aculcinapa. Her father, brother **Victoriano**, was greatly used of the Lord many years ago to spread the Gospel in many towns and villages among the sugar field workers of Veracruz and Oaxaca. There are at least five churches in these places where he was the first to share the Gospel. He would also become the mentor and teacher for **Mateo** (MITC staff member). One day the Lord called him "Home" in a car wreck as he returned from a Bible study in the mountains, leaving Alba's mother to raise her young daughter in the ways of the Lord. God provided grace and love for them to continue on and it was a special blessing to see her receive her diploma, following in her father's footsteps of sharing the Gospel of the Lord Jesus. Her Mom, **Lucy**, and her

for this legacy and partnership with Woodcreek Church in the work for the kingdom of God. The students served sharing the Gospel with children in Bible Clubs and working on construction and maintenance projects here on campus. For three days they went up to the mountain village of **Tecalatzompa** and worked on a church project and missionary house. **Bryan Colligan**, the youth pastor, did a great job leading these students.

Medical ministries continue to be a means of sharing the love of God and the Message of salvation. **Drs. Jeff and Carrie German** have for many years led teams down from **Brookwood Baptist Church**. In the last few years, their ministry has been instrumental to open towns to the Gospel among the Nahualt people. It has been great to see how places that would not have anything to do with Christians, after hearing of the love and healing brought by this team to towns nearby, suddenly ask for a visit to their location. This was the case again this year as they were able to have clinics in three new towns where there is no Christian

We are blessed to see the Lord's faithfulness through the years. It was great to have **Dr. Tom Marxen** and his family all the way from **Woodinville**, **Washington**, come to serve the Lord using his dental skills and expertise in our dental clinic here on campus and also in the villages in the mountains. Tom's first trip was back in 1986 as a young dentist, staying here and working with us for three months helping us set up the initial "on campus Dental Clinic". Tom and his family have been a faithful part of the MITC family all these years and now, to have him back serving with his family in Cordoba, was a great encouragement and blessing to us all.

Another team that has been faithfully coming down for many years is the Youth Group from **Woodcreek Church**. We have enjoyed seeing the youth come from this church to serve here since the early 1980's. This year in the group we actually had a parent/youth combo, in which the dad came down over twenty years ago as part of the same youth group in which now he was one of the group leaders with his son. We thank the Lord



church. We thank the Lord for continuing to allow us to be a part of taking His Light into the darkness, and seeing His church established in these remote areas of Mexico. Joining the team from Brookwood in the mountains was a youth/medical team from Summer Grove Baptist led by pastor Jacob Ambrose and Dr. Steen Trawick. They spent a day together doing work projects for the mountain mission church and holding a medical clinic and having a Bible Club for the children. It was a great impact in this mountain area to see love shared by these two groups. We also had this combined group serving here in the Cordoba area, all with the purpose of making the love of Jesus known.

Each summer, the Lord allows us to receive a large number of visitors who give their time, means and skills to come



and serve the Lord among us. It is a special blessing to see how the Lord uses in unique ways each of the groups that come to serve, enhancing the Christian testimony of MITC in the neighborhood and also in the region. We praise the Lord for His deeds among us and through us. All glory is to the Lord and thanks to the many willing hearts and hands that have joined us at this time.

We know that it is not possible for all of our MITC supporters to come down and see first-hand what God is doing here in Mexico. We are VERY thankful for you, who by Faith, continue to pray and give of your means to enable us to keep on serving.
