- **GASTRONOMY:** Tannat is a wild grape that produces wines which many times approach the implacable. The secret is in the correct extraction of the tannins during vinification. These wines combine well with exotic meats and dishes that are meaty and fat.

DESCRIPTION

- **VISUAL:** Purple red with good intensity.
- **NOSE:** Mature and wild, with raspberry and black fruit aromas, game, earth, strong spices, undergrowth vegetation, truffle and toasted aromas that become complex with age.
- **MOUTH:** Concentrated and vigorous on the palate, the tannin texture and the high alcoholic degree of the wine guarantee good consistence and persistence, and good evolution.
