Grape variety : 100% Mencía

Region : Bierzo, Spain

This wine has been produced by Victor Arroyo from Arroyo family vineyards which are located around the village of Pieros, and run along the pilgrim trail, in Bierzo, Spain. The vines used are over 70 years of age. This wine is aged in French, American and Hungarian oak barrels for duration of 7 months.

Tasting note

A chunky single varietal, oozing with black and red fruits combined with subtle oak undertones of balsamic character particularly from the Hungarian oak. A smooth rounded palate and medium to long finish make this a perfect accompaniment to red meat dishes, but also drinks very well on its own.
