About The Winegrowing Regions

It may sound obvious, but there is no other country in the world with such diverse terroir.

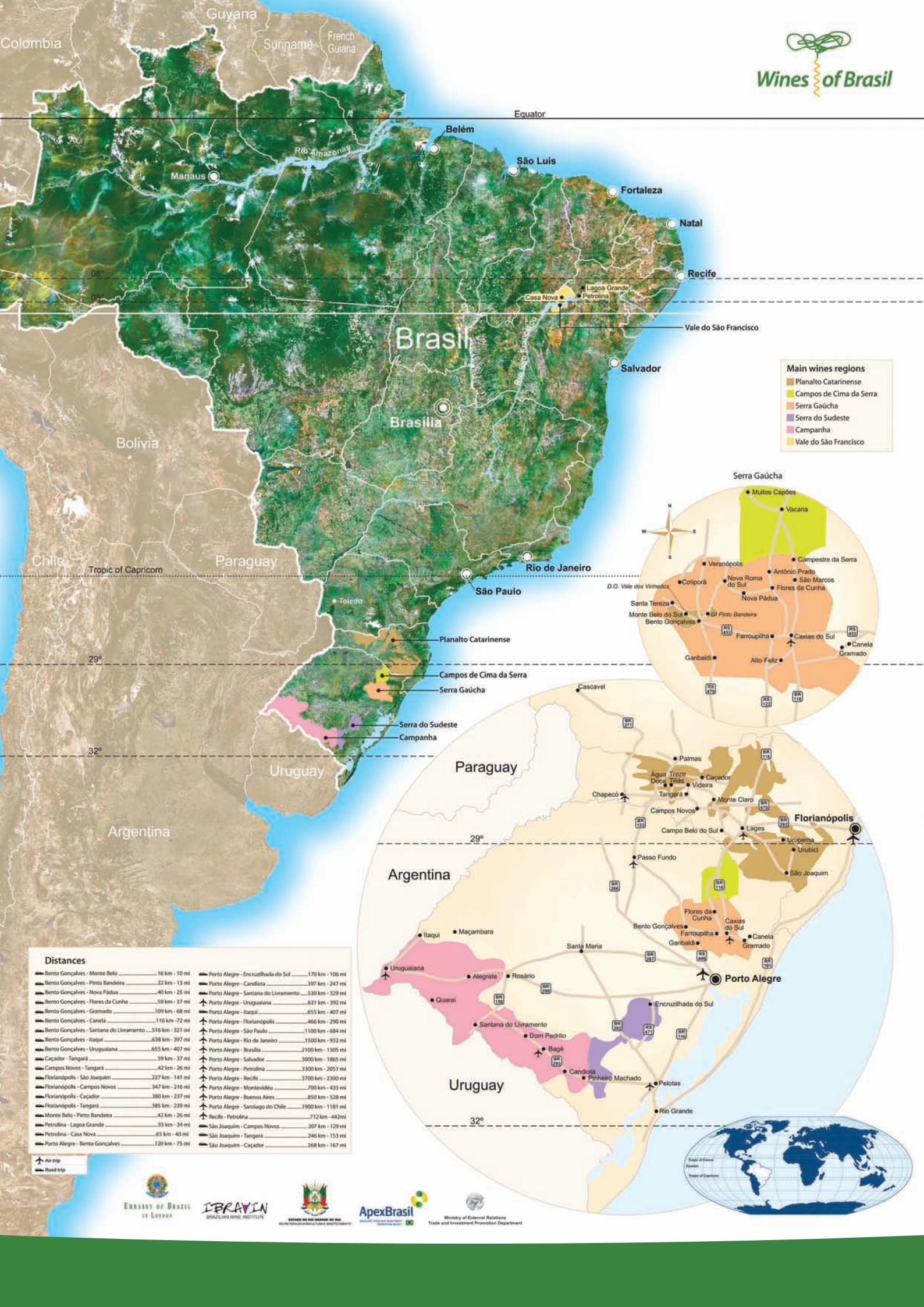
In Rio Grande do Sul (Serra Gaúcha, Campanha, Serra do Sudeste and Campos de Cima da Serra) the production is very similar to that in Europe with one harvest a year. The climate and terroir in Serra Gaucha is especially suited to sparkling wine production. The Campanha region, on the Uruguay border, is where more and more producers are going to grow grapes for Brazil's still wine production. Then in the Northeast, in the almost-arid region of Vale do São Francisco, in Bahia and Pernambuco states, you can harvest more than twice a year. In Santa Catarina you can pick frozen grapes.

The industry is moving fast; investment in technology as well as understanding of the regions means the potential is enormous.

About The Wines

Sparkling wines, Merlot and Moscato are a highlight, but Brazil is able to produce wines with widely different characteristics. However, they all have one thing in common – they are young, fresh and fruity with moderate levels of alcohol. This wine style matches perfectly with the Brazilian way of life: genuine and happy people with the ability to produce products to please different tastes and consumers.
