Three worthy bottles every week - for three different budgets

	TESCO FINEST PICPOUL DE PINET €9 Now wildly fashionable, this Languedoc white wine is tart and crisp (picpoul is dialect for 'lip stinger') and just the ticket with seafood. Tesco's version has a little extra ripeness and makes a fine apéritif.
	CHÂTEAU PEY LATOUR €10, SuperValu Certainly not worth anything like the 'full' price of €19.99 (who are they coddling?) but a very pleasant claret on special at a tenner - with a touch of blackcurrant, firm fruit and reasonably supple tannins. Good with roast beef.
	DUORUM €18.45, O'Brien's Tempranillo, Touriga Nacional and Touriga Franca from a couple of top winemakers in the Douro region of Portugal make a stunning, intense, complex, multi-layered wine with elegant seasoning from six months in French oak. Incredible value.
