What this Packet Contains

- Letter to parents.
- Map and directions. Check-in is from 11:30-12:30 on Sunday, June 4th. If you are going to be late, e-mail troy.fowler@ksbstate.org as soon as possible. We have members of the Kansas Highway Patrol on staff in the event of trouble. Messages can be relayed through them to me (and vice versa).
- Medical form. These will be collected at check-in.
NOTE: A KSHSAA physical form (or whatever form us used in your school district) for the 2016-17 school year MAY be substituted for the second page of the form provided that any new restrictions accompany the form.
- Samsung College Scholarship info. ELIGIBILITY: High school juniors who are a direct descendant, i.e. child, grandchild, great-grandchild or a legally adopted child, of a U.S. veteran who served during a period of war and is a delegate to either an American Legion Boys State or American Legion Auxiliary Girls State program.
