



Retired Teachers Needed!

The C&O Canal National Historical Park seeks experienced teachers to help deliver programs to K-12 students at Williamsport, Maryland. Help students experience a national park, exploring natural and historical resources in a setting that provokes thought, inspires wonder, and ignites understanding.



Join the Canal Classroom Corps: Spanning across the state of Maryland and bordering the Potomac River, the C&O Canal National Historical Park has an estimated 1,000,000 school-aged children within a 45-minute drive. The Canal Classroom Corps is a group of rangers, teachers, and volunteers who deliver K-12 education programs. In fall of 2013, the CCC will expand its offerings at Williamsport. Between four and six positions are available there.

Who should apply: Teachers must pass a background check and hold a current certificate in elementary or secondary education and have experience teaching, substitute teaching, or working with K-12 students in a school environment.

What: Teachers will deliver existing curriculum-based, on-site programs to groups as small as 12 and as large as 75. Teachers may also visit local schools to deliver programs. A daily stipend will be offered through the Canal Trust.

When: Mandatory two day training will be held in late July. Teachers will deliver programs at least one day a week (8:30 to 2:30) for approximately ten weeks starting in late August.

Where: C&O Canal NHP Visitor Center located in Williamsport, MD (Washington County).
