

BBQ RULES AND REGULATIONS

GENERAL RULES

1. Each team will consist of a chief cook and no more than three (3) assistant cooks.
2. All preparations and cooking shall be done within the confines of the team's assigned cooking space.
3. A chief cook or assistant MAY NOT enter more than one team per contest.
4. The chief cook will be held responsible for the conduct of their team and guests.
5. Violations of the rules and regulations of the contest may result in disqualification and/or expulsion from the grounds.
6. Each contestant shall supply all their own cooking ingredients and individual cooking devices.
7. Fresh water points will be available on the grounds.
8. No fires or live coals are allowed on the ground.
9. Each contestant is responsible for keeping their team's assigned cooking space clean.
10. Any use of alcoholic beverages on the grounds by contestants and/or guests will result in immediate removal from the premises.

COMPETITION RULES

1. The \$100 entry fee must be received by the entry deadline of May 5. A \$250 cash prize will be awarded to the winner.
2. All meat will be provided (Boston butts).
3. All meat will start out raw. No pre-seasoned meat. No food preparation will start until Friday, May 12 at 8 p.m. Judging will be done at 10 a.m., Saturday, May 13.
4. All meat must be 140 degrees or above after cooking.
5. Cleanliness of the cook, the cook's assistant, contest area, and utensils is required.
6. Contestants may use wood or gas grills.
7. If burn barrels are used to make coals, they must be screened to prevent sparks.
8. Each team is required to bring a fire extinguisher to keep near the pit.
