



WHO:

- **First Draft** is seeking artists to create an indoor art wall/gallery at our new Taproom + Kitchen in RiNo.
- Areas for placement of the wall renderings are shown below.
- There are 2 (two) wall sections of which one or more “panels” will support changing artwork over time.
- Selected artist(s) will have the opportunity to create a piece of public art, with private support, that supports their artistic vision for the wall space
- All media suitable for interior conditions (that does not interfere, damage, alter the existing structure/drywall) will be considered

SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Artist must be from the State of Colorado and at least 18 years of age
- Submit 8 (eight) hi-resolution images of your proposed work with an artist statement (who/why/what/how you like to work)
- Contact information
- Submittals are due by midnight, May 22, 2015 to info@firstdraftdenver.com
- Proposal of intended theme/concept
- Theme/art should be unique, but of similar nature to RiNo Arts District artwork
- Selected artist(s) will be required to sign a contract with First Draft

WHEN:

- The artist(s) selected are requested to begin work as soon as feasible in order to reach a completion and acceptance of the work on or before Friday, July 3, 2015
- Each panel size will vary — assume a large scale piece to be affixed to the wall
- Final size to be determined upon discussion with selected artist(s)

WHERE: Interior Wall space in 1309 26th St. in RiNo. Near the corner of Larimer St.

SELECT ARTIST(S) CAN EXPECT:

- First Draft will provide equipment and supplies which will be determined per artist needs and/or will offer a stipend to each selected artist(s)
- First Draft will document the process as well as interview to create a series of videos depicting the process of preparing and mounting the artwork
- To inspire and inform viewers and artists alike
- To express that Denver is a city that is coming into its own at the forefront of public art
- In other words, you will get some press!
- To provide their own transportation and accommodations if needed
- To work with seasonal constraints (weather, etc.) in Denver to meet expected deadline
