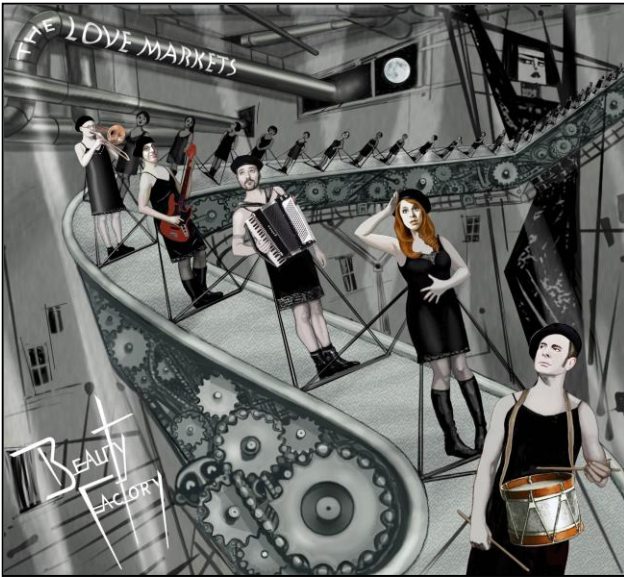

Welcome to The Love Markets, seekers of love and revolution in a world where everything is for sale. Led by singer-songwriter Angie Louise and inspired by the artists of 1920s Berlin, The Love Markets inject high-stakes edge and decadence into their modern mashup of bordello brass, political bite, sinuous rhythm and funky bass, luring you down alleys haunted by pulp heroines and into speakeasies brimming with subversion. Their second independent release, *Beauty Factory*, kicks off by conjuring a churning assembly line that whispers in our ears like a devil of advertising, promising to purge our imperfections: "Step up, miss! Here in the factory, the gates are always open... Don't resist! To be made whole again, you'll first need to be broken." Thumbing their noses at the machine, Louise's songs find heroes in unlikely places: romance aboard a freak-show caravan, a middle-aged housewife alone in a bar at happy hour, the accountant who sprouts fur and howls at the moon. Celebrating our fantasies and foibles with wit, exuberance and intoxicating soul, The Love Markets prove love and revolution can be found anywhere.
