Radio-Read Water Meters:

We have contracted with Dakota Supply Group for the new water meters. We are in the process of setting up dates for installation. You will be receiving letters in the mail very soon to set a date for your residence. Please respond to the letter immediately. There will be a phone number for you to call. Installations will start September 25 through 27th. After discussion, it was decided that it would be more fair and equitable for the residents to cover the cost of the meter itself (the same for each homeowner), and the City will cover the cost of installation, which can be more expensive depending on the circumstances of each home. There will be a couple of options for payment (one of them being you will have up to a year in payments added to your water bill). Questions can be addressed at the upcoming council meeting on Sept. 10.
