A seed was planted in July of 2012 for a new idea in campus ministry. In September, we launched our first attempt at “The Gathering” with over 60 people, most of them students, in attendance. Inspired by this success, others followed. In February we found a potential buyer for our church space in a horrible economy through a connection of one of our former students who is now back in Nigeria. Because of our loss of a large facility like our church building, we moved our Gatherings to a rotation of campuses with great enthusiasm (you can see pictures at [tpog.net](http://tpog.net)). In April we even hosted two Gatherings, one at Marquette and another at Wisconsin Lutheran High School. In late April, we formed our first Collegiate Council for college student leadership at TPOG. Students are excited to be part of what is happening. They are hearing the stories of God's faithfulness in our culture and in their lives. They are joining their stories to the heartbeat of God's word, a word that says Jesus came to bring Life! Spring has come!

Our goal is to make God's faithfulness known on campus and through all generations. Initially, I was unsure of what would happen to TPOG and WELS Campus Ministry in the Milwaukee area with this huge change. But after seeing the changes that have taken place thus far, I know TPOG has a great future ahead of it. Members of TPOG, students in Milwaukee area colleges like Marquette, MSOE, and UW-Milwaukee, and WELS believers citywide, are eager to start a new chapter for TPOG, and I could not be more excited to be a part of the process!

The Gathering is the new focal point of WELS Campus Ministry, and on the night April 10th, I was able to experience it for the first time.
