What’s Happening at TPOG

With weekly chapel and Bible studies underway this semester, TPOG students are able to regularly discuss their faith with fellow Christians. Vicar Ehlers has initiated the Lenten season on campus with a Chapel series that has students view Jesus’ last days from the perspective of his disciples. Bible study topics have been chosen by students themselves to be relevant for their generation. Topics this semester range from reading C.S. Lewis’ “The Screwtape Letters” to discussing in-depth the book of Revelation to watching and analyzing contemporary Christian music videos. Our Gathering series also addresses issues that our students request. This past year, based on students’ wishes, we have had Gathering speakers help us look at some very tough topics like creationism vs. evolution, the personal viewpoint of a Christian struggling with homosexuality, and the challenges of dating in our society in a God-pleasing way.
