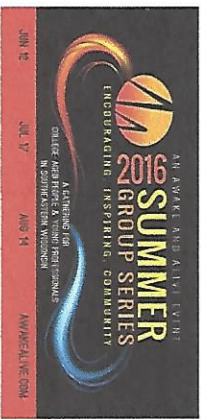


## Coming Up at TPOG in Summer 2016
