OUR "2" NEW VILLAGE'S



As we promised in the August newsletter, we would be announcing the name of our new village. Well.... God had a different idea. He has asked us to not stop at one. So it is with great joy that we share His plan. **LePina** (close to La Chapelle). About 20 miles southeast of Jumelle is the rural community of LePina. Fritz was first led there in 2009. Our first home visits with a team were in January 2010. Fritz and I returned in May, and were led to a small church. The church was started 15 years ago in the

pastors' home. The congregation is now over 100. The church where they worship is in bad shape. Walls are made of mud and rock, floor is dirt, no benches to speak of. The Pastor is trying to supply schooling to the children in the area with limited resources and is struggling.

Our tasks here will be to start with a church council. With them develop a plan for infrastructure and operations needed to get the school on a sustainable future. This will include the need for some kind of structure. The November team will be building benches and church altar here. We will also start a school lunch program soon.

Helping Hands for Haiti will be working in LePina with you, our partners, for many years.

Pte Riviere Just a few miles from Jumelle is the city of Pte Riviere. This small city is home to a large market where Jumelle operates its rice mill.

Between the Artibonite River and the canal rests a church that is not new to HH4H. We last worked there in 2005, when a team built benches for the Christian school. Funds were also supplied to add a concrete floor and secure the walls. A feeding program was started at the school also. Over the past year, due to many parents unable to pay the tuition for their children, the school has shut down. We have continued the feeding program and now we will restart the school. We hope to have classes started again by the time you read this newsletter.

Our tasks here will be to work with the existing church council on developing a business the school can run to fund the operations costs. We will be supporting them with funding for these operating costs as this plan is developed.
