#### THE EMANCIPATION PROCLAMATION

By President Abraham Lincoln as portrayed by Jim Getty September 12, 2012

Join us on Wednesday evening, September 12, 2012, as the Lowcountry Civil War Round Table will welcome back our friend and America's most revered President, the Honorable Abraham Lincoln, portrayed by Jim Getty. President Lincoln will unveil to our group his upcoming Emancipation Proclamation, which will free all persons held in bondage in all states and territories that are currently in rebellion against the United States of America. Please join us to hear our 16<sup>th</sup> President discuss why freedom must be granted now to the millions of slaves presently held in servitude in the Confederacy.

America's foremost Lincoln portrayer, historian, and scholar, Jim Getty was originally from central Illinois but now resides in historic Gettysburg where he portrays the 16<sup>th</sup> President in a one-man show during the tourist season. He holds a Master of Music degree from Illinois Wesleyan University, has taught choral music in high schools, and was director of choral activities at the University of Maine. As a member of the National Speakers Association, Jim Getty is incredibly busy giving leadership seminars to schools, colleges, corporations, and government agencies. He portrays President Lincoln on the Delta Queen Steamboat Company's Civil War Cruises, and his voice can be heard on two A & E programs as President Lincoln. We are extremely fortunate to present Jim Getty on the Sesquicentennial Anniversary of the Emancipation Proclamation and to kick off our 2012-13 program year.
